

Rules of Ready Golf
Goal:
Play round in 4 hours & 30 minutes or less

General

Keep sight of the group in front of you, not behind you

If the group in front of you is in the fairway, your group should be on the tee

Be ready to hit when group in front moves to next shot

Pick up if you have reached your max Under Equitable Stroke Control (See Chart at score posting station)

On the Tee

No “Honors” - The first player ready tees off (birdies and 9’s can tee off first if they are ready)

Carry an extra ball in case you need to re-tee

On the Fairway

Drop off rider (with clubs) Driver should proceed to their ball and hit

Hit when ready, but safely, no “Honors”

Watch other players hit shots to avoid looking for golf balls

After you hit, Get in the Cart with your club. You can clean and put on covers while driving to the next shot

Lost Ball

Drop player off who lost the ball. All other players go to your own ball. Hit and come back to help look for lost ball

Do not take more than 3 minutes to find lost ball

On the Green

Drop your rider in front of the green (with clubs) if necessary. Proceed and park carts behind the green and towards the next tee

If one player is having trouble around the green, others should putt up until player in trouble is ready

Study your shot and be ready to putt before it’s your turn

Whenever possible continue putting until holed out

1st player in the hole picks up the flag

Record scores at next tee while other players are teeing off
